Dairy Goat Pass-On project for Tanzanian Farmers

We started this project in Mareu Village (Kwa Filipo sub Village) with a group of 20 members and a chairman, who are collectively working to improve household income and nutrition through sustainable dairy goat farming.

4 Female goats have now been donated. According to the project model, the first and second offspring (kids) from each goat will be passed on to new members, while the original goats remain with the initial farmers. This "passon" system ensures sustainability, inclusivity, and the gradual expansion of benefits to the wider community.



In the first phase, hopefully 8 new goats will be distributed to new members. As the project progresses, the first and second generations of kids (a total of 16) will also be given to additional members. So, we hope we get more donations soon to give the other 4 goats to this project location, a goat is \$100, where is included vet, education, group meetings, etc.

Clean energy project

We have installed solar kits for 4 households in two villages in Mlandizi Ward, Kibaha District, in Tanzania's Coast Region (Pwani). The solar kits, each including a solar panel, battery, and four bright lights.



These systems now illuminate homes both inside and outside, creating safer, brighter environments for families and helping children study after sunset.

We select the households within our charity (womens) network, where it is known which families truggle the most and could use a light to make another step of progress in ther lives.

We thank you for 'bringing light and hope' into their homes.

Give 250 households clean water in Tanzania

We successfully completed the distribution of 13 water pipe rolls to three villages under the Makilenga Water Project here in Tanzania. Representatives from the respective village water committees welcomed us with a ceremony to accept the almost 2,000 metres of waterpipes for the Maruango Village – 4 rolls, the Ngajisosia Village – 6 rolls and the Malula Village – 3 rolls.

The community members have committed to excavating the trenches and laying the water pipes themselves. This initiative will significantly improve access to clean water and reduce the long distances currently travelled to fetch water. Destiny Specialists provided the transport of the rolls and donated a roll themselfs, for which we are very grateful.



Menstrual health education

On the 2nd of October we visited together with REEpads Tanzania the Kilimaji secondary school in Arusha for a menstrual health education session. We had 234! female participants from 12 to 17 years and 145 reusable sanitary pads were distributed to vulnerable students.



The training at Kalimaji Secondary School was a great success. By addressing sexual health, menstrual hygiene, and distributing sanitary pads, the program not only created awareness but also contributed to the wellbeing and academic performance of the girls.

We are so grateful that we could educate the young generation women

to be able to build up a better future for themselves and Tanzania. We hope you will help us to visit more schools in the future.

Other project updates

- Emergency Fund: After the elections the Emergency Fund was used to lighten the basic needs of the DHF organisation, so funds have run out. Hope we can build up again in 2026. We have no separate project for this on Global Giving but donations to Unrestricted support to our work in Tanzania will partly be put aside to this Fund.
- > **Send 10 Children to school**: Violeth is currently taking the final exams for graduating ordinary secondary education. New school fees will be needed next year.

- Fertile soil project, compost production education: Mr. Solomon, our trainer, is working on a new compost manure class in another village. We could not start in November, because of the travel restrictions, be we hope to start this class in 2026.
- Food and school supplies: We used the donated funds for menstrual health education, after approval of the major donor in July.
- ➤ **Wildlife Conservation:** We had some donations and will discuss with the rangers to give it a good destination.
- > Tree planting project: we have received already some nice donations, but we hope to plant more trees in March 2026!
